



SAFETY STATEMENT

Principles of Safety Management at TAA;

These principles shall be applicable to all airports on the premises managed and operated by TAA in Tanzania mainland:

The Director General carries the uppermost responsibility for safety Management of TAA managed Airports. The implementation of Safety Management is an Executive function of the line followed by all Directors, Managers, supervisors and employees who shall be responsible and accountable for their own safety and safety of others.

The Compliance Unit supports and coordinates the responsible lines in terms of operational planning and Implementation in accordance with specifications of the Safety Management System.

Guaranteed of a safe and healthily operating environment is the key success factor at all airports. In the daily operations the principle "safety first" shall apply and all safety relevant decisions shall be taken impersonally and by keeping in mind external business factors.

Through training and continued safety sensitization, the cooperating airport partners shall be enlightened to perceive and discharge their safety responsibilities in a daily work.

An open and transparent safety culture shall be created and promoted so that we can learn from events and/or near miss.

It is essential that all hazards, incidents and occurrences to be reported in a timely manner. TAA shall not initiate disciplinary action against an employee or contractor who reports a safety issue, violation, hazardous condition, error or near miss, or makes suggestions that seek to improve aviation safety (non-punitive Policy), except in cases involving negligence, recklessness, violations, unlawful acts, or sabotage, where the reporter or employee is deemed responsible for those acts and/or violations.

We at TAA are Committed to:

Enhance Safety Management System: By effective development and implementation of Safety Management System as an integral part to all our activities with the objective of achieving the highest levels of safety standards and performance.

Safety Culture:

Develop and embed a safety culture in all our activities that recognizes the importance and value of effective Safety Management and acknowledge at all times that safety is Paramount.

Safety Accountability and Responsibilities: Clearly defined to all staff that Accountabilities and Responsibilities for development and delivery of safety strategy and performance dwells on them, while TAA shall provide adequate and appropriate PPEs, safety information and training so as to build competence on safety matters.

Risk Management:

Minimize the Risks associated with Airports Operations to the point that is as low as reasonably practicable, meanwhile establish and measure our safety performance against realist Objectives and Targets.

Resource Allocation:

Ensure adequate resources are provided to efficiently and effectively implementation of safety policy and continually improve our safety performance.

Safety Oversight:

We shall Conduct Internal as well as External Audits, Management review to ensure that relevant actions are taken for improvement.

Applicability:

Ensure that every one who works for us, works with us or visit us, meets appropriate safety standards
